



Home Sleep Test COVID19 Safety Protocols

- Staff will wear personal protective equipment (PPE) to keep patients and staff safe.
- PPE will include masks, eyewear, gowns and gloves.
- Patients will be instructed to arrive alone, they cannot bring other family members to their appointment without prior approval.
- Staff will take each patient's temperature upon arrival and ask anyone with an elevated temperature to return at a later date.
- The home sleep testing devices will be sanitized and removed from service for 72 hours before being reissued.
- Disposable pieces of the device will be disposed of by the patient.
- Each device will be placed in a disposable container.

Home Sleep Device Pick Up Protocol

- Patients will be contacted and screened to schedule their home sleep test visit. They will be scheduled one per hour to eliminate any overlapping visits.
- Patients will be asked to watch the set-up video link on the SC website.
- Patients will be instructed to write down any questions or concerns after watching the set-up video.
- All patients will be instructed to wear mask and gloves when coming to the sleep center for their set-up appointment.
- The set-up video will be available for viewing if patient needs further instruction.
- Set-up tech will wear a sample home sleep test device for patients to see a visual explanation.
- Patient will be sent home with the device and instructed to bring it back the following business day.
- Patient will be instructed to dispose of nasal cannula when test is completed.
- Patient will be told they will be called with results in 14 days or less.
