

COVID-19: Screening Checklist – for Patients and Staff

On March 13, 2020, CMS and CDC updated guidance on restricting all non-essential healthcare. Once reopened, **ALL individuals** (staff, other health care workers, patients, visitors, etc.) entering the sleep center must be asked the following questions:

1. Has this individual washed their hands or used alcohol-based hand rub (ABHR) on entry?

- Yes No – please ask them to do so

2. Ask the individual if they have any of the following respiratory symptoms?

- If YES to any, restrict them from entering the sleep center.
- If NO to all, proceed to **question #3 for staff** and **question #4 for all others**.

3. For Staff & Health Care Providers (HCP) (e.g. agency staff or any health care workers who provide care to patients):

3A. Check temperature and document results: _____ Fever present?

- If YES, restrict from entering the sleep center.
- If NO, proceed to step 3B.

3B. Ask if they have worked in facilities or locations with recognized COVID-19 cases?

- If YES, ask if they worked with a person(s) with confirmed COVID-19?
- If YES, require them to wear PPE including mask, gloves, gown before any contact with patients & proceed to step 4.
 - If NO, proceed to step 4.

4. Allow entry to sleep center and remind the individual to:

- Wash their hands or use ABHR throughout their time in the sleep center.
 Not shake hands with, touch or hug individuals during their visit.

<input type="checkbox"/> Must wear a facemask and gloves while in the sleep center and can only accompany the patient with prior approval from the sleep center staff.	<p>When there are cases in the community but none in this facility:</p> <input type="checkbox"/> Consider implementing universal use of facemasks for all HCP while in this facility. <p>When there are cases in this facility OR sustained transmission in the community:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Implement universal use of facemask for all HCP while in this facility. Consider having HCP wear all recommended PPE (gown, gloves, eye protection, N95 respirator or, if not available, a facemask) for the care of all patients, regardless of presence of symptoms. Implement protocols for extended use of eye protection & facemasks.
